**RESOLUTION APPROVING THE MAXIMUM PROPERTY TAX DOLLARS FOR  
BUDGET YEAR JULY 1, 2020 TO JUNE 30, 2021**

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Harlan have considered the proposed FY21 city maximum property tax dollars for the affected levy total, and

WHEREAS, a notice concerning the proposed city maximum property tax dollars was published as required and posted on city web site and social media accounts, and

WHEREAS, a public hearing concerning the proposed city maximum property tax dollars was held on February 18, 2020.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Harlan that the maximum property tax dollars for the affected tax levies for FY21 shall not exceed the following total:

Total maximum levy for affected property tax levies - \$2,367,252

The Maximum Property Tax dollars requested in the total maximum levy for affected property tax levies for FY21 represents an increase of greater than 2% from the Maximum Property Tax dollars requested for FY20.




