Welcome to the Harlan Dog Park Dog Park Hours: Sunrise to Sunset

We want you and your dog to enjoy the park, so we have guidelines for park safety.

RULES:

- Enter at your own risk. Dog owners are legally and financially liable for injuries or damage caused by their dogs.
- **Do not bring aggressive dogs into the park**. Any dog must be removed from the park at the first sign of intending to harm another dog.
- **Dogs must be leashed and restrained** when entering or leaving the dog park.
- Please clean up after your dog. If you did not bring waste bags with you, there are some provided at the waste stations. Encourage others to clean up after their dogs, too. After you pick up your dog's waste, tie the bag and place it in the designated doggie waste receptacle.
- Our dog park is for dogs to play safely off leash; however, they must be always supervised by their handlers inside the park boundaries. Handlers must always have their dogs' leashes with them.
- All dogs must be up to date on their vaccinations and wear a visible current rabies tag. All dogs must have licenses as required.
- **Do not bring pet food or people food** into the dog park if your dog needs a drink, please bring your own non-breakable bowl. No glass, pottery and other breakable materials are allowed in the dog park.

- If you bring balls, Frisbees, or other toys, be prepared to share them with other dogs. No motorized toys or equipment are allowed within the confines of the dog park.
- **Please bring no more than two dogs** with you when you come to the park to play.

PROHIBITIONS:

- NO female dogs in season (heat)
- NO smoking, alcoholic beverages, eating or littering in the dog park
- NO children under 12 years old unless accompanied by an adult
- NO puppies under the age of 6 months, due to lack of vaccinations
- NO unvaccinated dogs in the dog park
