

ORDINANCE NO. 2025-01

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF HARLAN, IOWA, BY AMENDING SUBSECTION 41.12(9)(F)(1) AND (2) PERTAINING TO FIREWORKS AND DISCHARGE

BE IT ENACTED by the City Council of the City of Harlan Iowa:

SECTION 1. SECTION MODIFIED. Section 41.12(9)(F)(1) and (2) of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Harlan, Iowa, is repealed and the following adopted in lieu thereof:

41.12 FIREWORKS REGULATIONS. The sale and use of fireworks are regulated as follows:

9. Fireworks use and discharge, general requirements:

F. Consumer Fireworks. It is unlawful for any person to use or explode consumer fireworks within the City outside of the following dates:

(1) State Code Dates. Allowed by Section 364.2(6) of the *Code of Iowa*:

- a. July 3 between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 10:00 p.m.
Except when July 3 falls on a Saturday or Sunday preceding July 4, in which fireworks shall be allowed between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 11:00 p.m.
- b. July 4 between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 11:00 p.m.
- c. December 31 between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 12:30 a.m. on the immediately following day.

(2) City Allowed Dates.

- a. No other dates or times permitted.

SECTION 2. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. If any section, provision, or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any section, provision, or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 3. WHEN EFFECTIVE. This ordinance shall be in effect from and after its final passage, approval, and publication as provided by law.
