

**ORDINANCE NO. 2025-01****AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF HARLAN, IOWA, BY AMENDING SUBSECTION 41.12(9)(F)(1) AND (2) PERTAINING TO FIREWORKS AND DISCHARGE**

**BE IT ENACTED** by the City Council of the City of Harlan Iowa:

**SECTION 1. SECTION MODIFIED.** Section 41.12(9)(F)(1) and (2) of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Harlan, Iowa, is repealed and the following adopted in lieu thereof:

**41.12 FIREWORKS REGULATIONS.** The sale and use of fireworks are regulated as follows:

9. Fireworks use and discharge, general requirements:

F. Consumer Fireworks. It is unlawful for any person to use or explode consumer fireworks within the City outside of the following dates:

(1) State Code Dates. Allowed by Section 364.2(6) of the *Code of Iowa*:

a. July 3 between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 10:00 p.m.

Except when July 3 falls on a Saturday or Sunday preceding July 4, in which fireworks shall be allowed between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 11:00 p.m.

b. July 4 between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 11:00 p.m.

c. December 31 between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 12:30 a.m. on the immediately following day.

(2) City Allowed Dates.

a. No other dates or times permitted.


**SECTION 2. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE.** If any section, provision, or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any section, provision, or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

**SECTION 3. WHEN EFFECTIVE.** This ordinance shall be in effect from and after its final passage, approval, and publication as provided by law.
