American Test Center will be at the Harlan Fire Department on June 27th to test Ladder 28 and all the ground ladders

July 4th Fireworks – needing help at dusk

Shelby County Fair Parade will be July 11th – needing someone (child) to ride in the remote firetruck in the parade. No decision was made at this time.
